Assistant County Commissioner - Programme (Explorer Scouts)



Outline: To work in partnership with the County Commissioner and Deputy County Commissioner - Programme to ensure effective operation of the Programme across Lincolnshire in accordance with the rules as laid down in POR of The Scout Association.

Responsible to: Deputy County Commissioner - Programme

Main Contacts: CC, DCC-Programme, DCs, County & District Programme Teams, District & County Advisers, County Administrator FDOs, HQ, UK Advisers, other Counties Programme Teams, GirlGuiding UK, Schools and other local Youth Organisations.

Appointment Requirements: To understand and accept The Scout Association's policies, have a satisfactory disclosure (DBS), Completion of Wood Badge, which includes the Section Supporter Modules as detailed in the Adult's Personal File and The Scout Association's Adult Training Scheme.

General Tasks:

- Promote and encourage the implementation of all policies of The Scout Association
- Maintain a working relationship with DCs, District & County Programme Teams.
- Assist District Programme Teams in the encouragement of all Leaders to provide a balanced programme.
- Represent the County Team as required at events across Lincolnshire/the East Midlands and nationally.
- Work in partnership with the CC & DCC-Programme in the management and development of the County.
- Support the CC, DCC-Programme and the CTM with the learning needs of Leaders and Commissioners
- Support District Programme Teams as required.
- Promote Scouting to the local Community.

Explorer Section Specific Tasks:

- Ensure the purpose, method, policies and programme are carried out throughout the Explorer Scout Section in the County.
- Co-operate with DCs to support all Leaders and Commissioners in matters relating to the Explorer Scout Section and its Leaders.
- Promote and support the completion of the Top Awards and Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme across the sections.
- Run regular DESC meetings (at least two per year).
- Positively promote linking between sections whilst also promoting other volunteering opportunities within the Association post 18.
